Xtrackers Short Duration High Yield Bond ETF seeks investment results that correspond generally to the performance, before fees and expenses, of the Solactive USD High Yield Corporates Total Market 0-5 Year Index, a rules-based, market value weighted Index designed to track the performance of High Yield rated corporate bonds issued in USD with 0 to 5 years term to maturity.

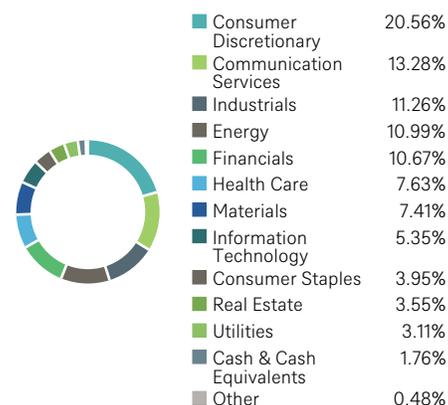

While the 10-year overall rating formula seems to give the most weight to the 10-year period, the most recent three-year period actually has the greatest impact because it is included in all three rating periods.
